<p>Legalized the right for married couples to access contraception nationwide.</p>	<p>Introduced to address wage discrepancies between men and women after Census Data revealed that women's median income was 54%-77% of white men's median income. The Act failed to pass in the Senate, and was filibustered twice two years later.</p>	<p>Criminalized domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking. In later reauthorizations, these protections were extended to include LGBTQIA+ and undocumented persons regardless of legal status.</p>	<p>Guaranteed equal access to academic and athletic resources regardless of gender.</p>	<p>Outlawed employers from asking women if or when they plan on having children, and required employers to offer men and women the same benefits.</p>
