<p>Amplify (Verb): To increase the volume of (sound), especially using an amplifier.</p>	<p>Can you think of an instance where you might use an amplifier? Do you know of any music that is amplified?</p>
<p>Electronics (Noun): Known by many people in your community.</p>	<p>Name three common objects that include electronics.</p>
<p>Influential (Adjective): Having great influence on someone or something.</p>	<p>Why is it important to be a positive influence on other people?</p>
<p>Mass-Produced (Adjective): manufactured in large quantities by an automated mechanical process.</p>	<p>Why might a product be mass-produced? What might be the benefits and deficits to mass-producing a product?</p>
<p>Patent (Noun): The exclusive right granted by a government to an inventor to manufacture, use, or sell an invention.</p>	<p>Why might it be important to receive a patent for an invention?</p>
<p>Tinkerer (Noun): A person who enjoys fixing and experimenting with machines and their parts.</p>	<p>Do you know anyone who is a tinkerer or do you like being a tinkerer yourself?</p>
