Legislative Process

Adjective: The action or process by which a bill becomes a law.

Advocate

Verb: To support or argue for something you believe is important, to plead in favor of something.

Accomplishment

Noun: An achievement, something that has been accomplished.

Dr. Martin Luther King National Holiday

Noun: A legal holiday established by the national government to celebrate the life and accomplishments of Dr. King.
